ARRIVAL:

Guests may start arriving and parking at 12pm CT on Friday, August 29th.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE: enter on Darrell Waltrip Dr from SR 452/Bill France Blvd. Turn left on Sterling Marlin Dr and make your way to the camper Entry Point.

DEPARTURE:

Motorcoaches/RVs are restricted from departing the camping areas during the times of 4:30PM-7:30PM on August 31. Passenger vehicles may exit immediately. Tennessee State Patrol and local Law Enforcement will control the release of all campers and large vehicles following the conclusion of the days final event.

All campers must depart Nashville Superspeedway by 12pm on Monday, September 1.

GENERAL CAMPING REGULATIONS:

CAMPING HOURS:

Gates open at 12:00PM, Friday, August 29th and close at 12pm on Monday, September 1st. **Quiet hours** are enforced from 1:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M. each night. Loud music, large gatherings and unruly behavior is prohibited during this time. Admittance and set-up are restricted when gates are closed.

CAMPING RULES:

- Tent Camping is a portion of the Glade Campground, outside turns 3 and 4.
- · No tents are allowed in RV Camping areas.
- Each tent campsite is unreserved and comes with a tow vehicle pass. No generators, of any kind, are allowed in tent camping.
- RV/Campers: Reserved 25x50 space in dry camping. Space does not include power, water or view of the track unless otherwise noted
- RV's are not permitted to relocate once personnel have assigned a spot

CAMPING AREA REGULATIONS:

- Camping site does not come with grandstand tickets.
- Weapons of any kind, drones, remote control helicopters, planes or other remote-controlled devices, fireworks, sky lanterns, missile-like objects or projectiles of any kind, explosives and illegal substances are all prohibited. Anyone caught using these items will have them confiscated, and a citation may be issued by city or county law enforcement.
- Charcoal fires are permitted only in standard outdoor cooking grills.
- All pets need to be harnessed, leashed or tethered when outside of your RV. Please clean up after your pets. Pets are NOT allowed outside of campgrounds.
- Please place your trash in one of our dumpsters, which can be found throughout the Campgrounds.


CAMPING AREA REGULATIONS Continued:

- During an emergency, please call 911 immediately; please identify yourself and your campsite location by Section and Site number. Event Officials will be monitoring emergency channels and will be able to assist emergency personnel in location the incident inside the campgrounds. Event Officials also have medical and fire team staffed twenty-four (24) hours a day during race weekends. They may be the first to respond to the incident.

SEVERE WEATHER PREP & COMMUNICATIONS:

KNOW YOUR PLAN!

STAY ALERT. BE PROACTIVE.

- STAY ALERT: Monitor the weather closely and take the necessary precautions to ensure your safety. Iowa Speedway may not provide adequate protection from extremely high winds, lighting, hail, or tornadoes. There is no basement or approved tornado shelter on property.
- SECURE LOOSE ITEMS: If you are tailgating or camping, please secure loose items including tents, grills, coolers, flags, and awnings. Seek shelter if conditions worsen.
- LIGHTNING: Lightning can strike as far as 10 to 15 miles from the area where it is raining.

 That's about the distance you can hear thunder. The National Weather Service indicates if you can hear thunder, you are within striking distance, and it recommends seeking shelter immediately.
- SHELTER: Though no place is absolutely safe from severe weather, if you are caught outside, the safest location is a large enclosed building. Iowa Speedway has limited enclosed buildings, and if any guests are unable to seek shelter in an enclosed structure, the National Weather Service recommends seeking shelter in an enclosed metal vehicle. The National Weather Service also recommends staying away from tall, isolated objects.
